Background



A career in academics and research has always been a challenge with strict requirements on qualification, research, and publication in high-impact top-ranking journals. The phrase 'publish or perish' is more relevant than ever as the pressure, constraint, and stress associated with publication increases. This is further aggravated by increase in new popular sounding journals. It is important that even before one considers a career in academics, they should work towards publication along with their education in undergraduate and postgraduate studies. The non-native English speaking community finds it even more difficult to pen their work. As a result of this, the novice authors feel lost and burned out sooner than later. This course is designed to help beginners in the art and science of the publication of scholarly articles.
