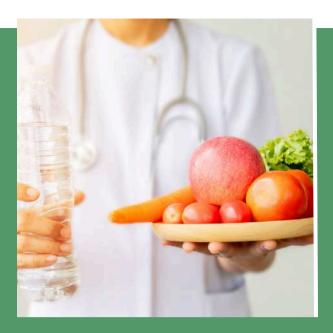

Course Overview:



The Certificate Program in Public Health Nutrition is a comprehensive program designed to equip participants with the essential knowledge and skills to tackle critical nutritional challenges faced by diverse populations. This program offers an in-depth exploration of key topics, beginning with an introduction to Public Health Nutrition and extending through vital areas such as nutrient requirements and dietary guidelines across the lifespan.

Participants will delve into the epidemiology of nutrition, focusing on strategies to combat the triple burden of malnutrition: undernutrition, micronutrient deficiencies, and overweight/obesity. The course also covers national nutrition policy & programs, food safety initiatives and effective nutrition program management. Advanced modules on nutritional surveillance techniques for anthropometric and dietary assessment, as well as behaviour change strategies through Information (IEC) and Social Behaviour Change Communication (SBCC), will empower learners to implement effective public health nutrition interventions to achieve sustainable outcomes.

Course Objective:

The objective of the course is to equip participants with comprehensive knowledge and practical skills to address malnutrition through dietary interventions, enhance nutrition program management and achieve public health nutrition outcomes through effective strategies.

Learning Outcomes:

After completing this course, the participant will be able to:

- Assess nutrient needs for diverse populations by gaining a comprehensive understanding of public health nutrition principles, nutrition fundamentals, dietary requirement of different age groups and determinants of nutritional status.
- Conduct nutritional assessment and surveillance utilizing anthropometric and dietary assessment techniques.
- Develop competencies to manage nutrition programs and interventions, with a focus on national initiatives including supplementation and fortification.
