## 1. Pattern for Examination

The Examinations at IIHMR Bangalore consists of two kinds of exams i.e .MTA (Mid-Term Assessment) and the Term End Examination (TEE).

### A. Mid Term Assessment (MTA) 30 Marks

1. During Mid Term assessment (MTA) is a mandatory part of all the modules. The total marks allocated for the MTA are 30 Marks.
2. MTA should be conducted in the blue book duly signed by the course coordinator and by the respective student
3. The MTA marks submission along with the attendance sheet : The soft copy/ hard copy of the MTA marksheet (out of 30) is to be mailed to the Controller of Examination within one week of the course completion.
4. The format Mid Term assessment (MTA) question paper is left to the discretion of NBA Guidelines. And should total up to 30 marks.
5. Internal Marks (Mid Term Assessment marks) will be rounded off to a whole number for convenience of grading.
6. It is important for the students to secure 50% Marks in MTA to get pass marks else student have to reappear in the MTA Examination.
7. Student should have minimum 75% attendance to appear for MTA Examination.
8. If students Skips or Absent in MTA Examination apart from Emergency cases such as (Self Marriage, Medical grounds , Participation in Institute activities, Demise in Family, Late joiners) which got duly approved from Controller of Examination and Associate Dean Academics then under such circumstance student will have to seat for Complimentary Examination else it will be considered as Supplementary.
9. Students who are absent in MTA wont be eligible to attend Term end examination
10. After Getting Approval Student should update Course Co-Ordinator too about his condition for non-appearing in the MTA Examination.

### B. The Term End Examinations (TEE)

1. The term end examinations will be conducted at the end of each term.
2. The schedule for the examination set by the academic office and the dates for the exam are based on the sequential order of the modules.
3. The term end examination question paper format is at the discretion of NBA Guidelines.
4. Maximum marks for TEE will be for 70. The duration of the examination will be 180 minutes (3 Hours).
5. External Marks (term end examination marks) will be rounded off to a whole number for convenience of grading. *Jesha Manjunath*
6. If Student fails to achieve 50% Marks in TEE Examination, then under such

- circumstance they have to appear in the Supplementary Examination.
7. If students Skips or Absent in TEE Examination apart from Emergency cases such as (Self Marriage, Late joiners, Medical grounds , Participation in Institute activities, Demise in Family) which got duly approved from Controller of Examination and Associate Dean Academics, then under such circumstance student will have to seat for Complimentary Examination else it will be considered as Supplementary.
  8. After Getting Approval Student should update Course Co-Ordinator too about his condition for non-appearing in the TEE Examination

#### **GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE EXAMINATION: -**

01. The link to join the examination is shared on scheduled day of the examination.
02. All the students should join "Microsoft Teams" link with their respective official id only. Guest Login is prohibited/not permitted.
03. Students are requested to open Microsoft Teams and join the meeting/link before 15 mins of examination time (9:45 AM). Don't join the meeting/link using Chrome/Firefox/Opera and other browser.
04. All students should ensure availability of camera during the examination either using Desktop PC with webcam or laptop. Ensure camera is functional with clarity.
05. Student should enable the camera as soon as they join the link.
06. Camera should be positioned in such a way that complete writing position is visible including their head and hands.
07. Camera should be turned on during the examinations. Ensure proper connectivity and network before the examination.
08. Students who have network issues, kindly join the institute for the examination.
09. Student should delete browsing history such as Temporary files, Recent Files, browsing history before the start of examination.
10. Except pencil box, water bottle and calculator, no other items should be on the table.
11. If any student is found guilty or any kind of mischief, invigilator can access student system and take necessary actions.
- 09 Student are supposed to give permission to invigilator if asked for system access.

2. The minimum attendance required to appear in the examination is 75%. The only area of exception is on medical grounds where appropriate documents need to be submitted to the academic office. Under any given circumstances including medical grounds, Self-Marriage, Demise in the family, Pregnancy and Maternity and Participation in Institutional Activity students are allowed to appear in the Complimentary Examination.
3. Course Faculty can waive 5%, 10% can be waived by the Dean, Academics, and the Director is empowered to take a decision for students till 60% with subjective evidence. If the attendance is less than 60% then the student will be denied permission to appear in the examination.
4. The final list of students eligible for the examinations is prepared by the Academic office.

***Process of addressing grievances for shortage of attendance / MTA marks***

1. Any issues pertaining to the eligibility of the students to take the exams should be addressed to Controller of Examinations and the Dean, Academics.
2. Counseling needs to be undertaken for each student individually and an undertaking letter needs to be collected from the student regarding the status of his/her eligibility to take the exam. (Undertaking letter enclosed)
3. Counseling for the students should be undertaken individually based on the MTA marks and attendance.

**Hall Ticket**

- A candidate entering the examination hall must possess hall-ticket and identity card issued by the authorities concerned

### 3. Schedule for Examination

1. The schedule for the examination should be issued by the Academic office and printed a week before the exams.
2. Invigilation: The Controller of Examination will schedule the invigilation duty of faculty. Schedule will be circulated among the faculty for their signature. Each faculty should ensure to be present for the invigilation on the assigned day.
3. For every 30 students, 1 faculty shall be assigned for invigilation. If case of more than 30 students in the same hall, 1 faculty should be supported by 1 staff member. Assigned invigilator should report atleast 30 mins before the actual time of commencement of exam.
4. In case the faculty/ staff assigned on invigilation duty on the specified day is unable to do the invigilation, it is her/his responsibility to make alternative arrangements and inform by writing the same in mail to the Controller of Examination.

### 5. Code of conduct:

- (a) A code of conduct should be issued to all the students and acknowledgement should be collected .
- (b) Dos & Don'ts: Invigilators should follow the Do's and Don't during the invigilation duty (Attached for reference)
- (c) Answer Booklets: The answer booklets for the end term have been created

separately. No additional booklets will be provided to students.

- (d) Seating Arrangement in the Examination hall: The seating arrangement in the examination hall with roll numbers should be assigned 1 day prior and should be changed for each paper to avoid malpractice.

#### **4. Obstruction in Conduct of Examination :**

If Examination cannot be conducted due to unforeseen reasons , the particular exam will be conducted as per the dates issued by the COE based on suggestions from examination committee meeting.

#### **5. Evaluations**

1. The answer booklets (Any confidentiality /Anonymous Sheet) for evaluations are submitted to the course coordinator after completion of term end examination by the Academic office.
2. The evaluations should be completed and results should be published within 21 days of receiving the answer scripts from the Academic Office.

#### **6. Result Announcement**

1. The results will be prepared by the Academic office and verified by the Controller of Examination and Dean-Academics.
2. Controller of Examination shall hold meeting with the Examination Committee to review the results before announcing the results.
3. The results will be signed by the Chairperson, Controller of Examination and Dean Academics and displayed in the notice board.
4. A copy of the result shall be sent to the parents through the e-mail provided during admission by the Academic department. In case of absence of email, hard copy of the result shall be send to the parents.
5. Failure: A student who does not procure the minimum marks for qualifying i.e. 50 marks out of 100 is termed as 'failed'. The 50 marks aggregate is a sum of both MTA and TEE. Its compulsory for student to Secure 15 Marks out of 30 in MTA and 35 out of 70 in TEE Examination.

#### **7. Grace marks**

A total of 8 marks for the entire 2 years is available as 'grace' - the tally of which is maintained by the Controller of Examination's office. These grace marks can be used only if the candidate has failed in 2 or less than 2 subjects. If in a given term the candidate has failed in 3 subjects the concept of grace marks is not applicable. Students who would like to avail the grace marks shall submit the letter to the Controller of Examination. Controller of Examination shall call for a meeting with the Examination Committee and decide. In case a student is granted grace marks, Examination Committee should duly sign and keep record of the same for future use.

## 6. Re-Examination

1. **Supplementary exam:** The students who were not eligible due to shortage of attendance or failed in the exams have to take the supplementary exam in the next cycle of exams or otherwise whenever held by the Controller of Examinations. Supplementary Should be of 70 Marks Examination.
2. Students are allowed to appear only 2 times for the supplementary exam for each module. Those who fails after writing supplementary exam 2 times for a subject/module will have to appear for the exam in the next academic year.
3. Students will be marked as "P" in their score card irrespective of the marks they score in the supplementary exam.
4. **Complementary Exam:** A complementary exam (Along with the supplementary examination with regular grades) will be conducted for the students who were absent either due to illness or taken leave for bank loans upon approval of the Course Coordinator and Dean Academics. This excludes ineligible candidates
5. The students appearing for supplementary examinations have to pay fee prescribed by the management.

## 8. Re-Evaluation & Sitting for Supplementary Exam

1. *Re-evaluation of the answer scripts can be done on the payment of Rs.500/ (Five Hundred) per subject. A student can re-evaluate a maximum of three papers per term. In case there is a difference of marks the Academic office will consider the highest for the purpose of result.*
2. The score sheet of the previous evaluation will be blinded and not available to the evaluator while doing re-evaluation. Re-evaluation scores should be marked in the separate evaluation sheet/scoring sheet available in the answer booklet.
3. For Repeat Examination (Supplementary Exam) students need to deposit Rs 500/- as Repeat Examination fees at institute account.
4. For Repeat Examination (Supplementary Exam) students need to deposit Rs 500/- as Repeat Examination fees at institute account and submit the Reevaluation form to the examination cell

## 15. Criteria to Pass in Subjects

### 15.1. First Year Examination

**Main Subjects:** The student is declared to have passed in a subject, if he/she secures, 50% of marks minimum in MTA and Term End individually.

### 15.2. Second Year Examination

**Main Subjects:** The student is declared to have passed the examination in a subject if he/she secures 50% of the marks minimum in MTA and Term End individually.

## 16. Criteria to Pass in First Year Examination

The student shall be declared to have passed in first year examination if he/she passes in all the main subjects.

## 17. Carry Over Benefit for First Year

A student who fails in any 2 of the 14 main subjects of first year shall be permitted to carry over those subjects to the second year.

## 18. Eligibility to Award the PGDM Degree

1. Transcript - A student shall have passed in all the subjects of first, second year and also submit the summer training report along with the dissertation report to be eligible for award of degree Certificates.

## 19. Gold Medal

### 1. Specialization-wise Gold Medalist Guideline (Academic Excellence)

- A Gold Medal will be awarded to a student who has passed all the prescribed examinations in first attempt and scored highest marks in the respective specialisation

### 2. GOLD MEDAL for best all-round achievement guideline

Best All-Round Performer Gold Medal will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Student who has passed all the prescribed examinations in the first attempt and ranked in the first 15 in overall Batch scoring - 50% weightage
- Participation in Extra Curricular Activities and Co-Curricular Activities – 10% weightage
- Overall Behaviour in last two years - 10% weightage
- Member of academic/institutional committees - 10% weightage
- Paper presentation/ Paper publication - 20% weightage



## 1. Pattern for Examination

The Examinations at IIHMR Bangalore consists of two kinds of exams i.e .MTA (Mid-Term Assessment) and the Term End Examination (TEE).

### A. Mid Term Assessment (MTA) 30 Marks

1. During Mid Term assessment (MTA) is a mandatory part of all the modules. The total marks allocated for the MTA are 30 Marks.
2. MTA should be conducted in the blue book duly signed by the course coordinator and by the respective student
3. The MTA marks submission along with the attendance sheet : The soft copy/ hard copy of the MTA marksheet (out of 30) is to be mailed to the Controller of Examination within one week of the course completion.
4. The format Mid Term assessment (MTA) question paper is left to the discretion of NBA Guidelines. And should total up to 30 marks.
5. Internal Marks (Mid Term Assessment marks) will be rounded off to a whole number for convenience of grading.
6. It is important for the students to secure 50% Marks in MTA to get pass marks else student have to reappear in the MTA Examination.
7. Student should have minimum 75% attendance to appear for MTA Examination.
8. If students Skips or Absent in MTA Examination apart from Emergency cases such as (Self Marriage, Medical grounds , Participation in Institute activities, Demise in Family, Late joiners) which got duly approved from Controller of Examination and Associate Dean Academics then under such circumstance student will have to seat for Complimentary Examination else it will be considered as Supplementary.
9. Students who are absent in MTA wont be eligible to attend Term end examination
10. After Getting Approval Student should update Course Co-Ordinator too about his condition for non-appearing in the MTA Examination.

### B. The Term End Examinations (TEE)

1. The term end examinations will be conducted at the end of each term.
2. The schedule for the examination set by the academic office and the dates for the exam are based on the sequential order of the modules.
3. The term end examination question paper format is at the discretion of NBA Guidelines.
4. Maximum marks for TEE will be for 70. The duration of the examination will be 180 minutes (3 Hours).
5. External Marks (term end examination marks) will be rounded off to a whole number for convenience of grading.
6. If Student fails to achieve 50% Marks in TEE Examination, then under such

- circumstance they have to appear in the Supplementary Examination.
7. If students Skips or Absent in TEE Examination apart from Emergency cases such as (Self Marriage, Late joiners, Medical grounds , Participation in Institute activities, Demise in Family) which got duly approved from Controller of Examination and Associate Dean Academics, then under such circumstance student will have to seat for Complimentary Examination else it will be considered as Supplementary.
  8. After Getting Approval Student should update Course Co-Ordinator too about his condition for non-appearing in the TEE Examination

#### **GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE EXAMINATION: -**

01. The link to join the examination is shared on scheduled day of the examination.
02. All the students should join "Microsoft Teams" link with their respective official id only. Guest Login is prohibited/not permitted.
03. Students are requested to open Microsoft Teams and join the meeting/link before 15 mins of examination time (9:45 AM). Don't join the meeting/link using Chrome/Firefox/Opera and other browser.
04. All students should ensure availability of camera during the examination either using Desktop PC with webcam or laptop. Ensure camera is functional with clarity.
05. Student should enable the camera as soon as they join the link.
06. Camera should be positioned in such a way that complete writing position is visible including their head and hands.
07. Camera should be turned on during the examinations. Ensure proper connectivity and network before the examination.
08. Students who have network issues, kindly join the institute for the examination.
09. Student should delete browsing history such as Temporary files, Recent Files, browsing history before the start of examination.
10. Except pencil box, water bottle and calculator, no other items should be on the table.
11. If any student is found guilty or any kind of mischief, invigilator can access student system and take necessary actions.
12. Student are supposed to give permission to invigilator if asked for system access.
13. No documents related to examination subject should be opened in the system except question paper. You can take backup of all the documents before the examination.
14. Students are not allowed to leave their place during the examination. Only 5 mins break for two times are allowed during 3 hours with permission from the invigilator.
15. Invigilator are assigned for all the examinations.
16. Electricity issue or any kind of interruption are not accepted during the examinations. Ensure availability of all types of resources before the examinations

#### **GUIDELINES FOR OFFLINE EXAMINATION: -**

- Students appearing for offline examination need to report to the institute atleast half an hour before the scheduled examination time. Students should enter the examination hall atleast 15 mins before the examination.
- Except Pencil Box , Water bottle and calculator, no other items are allowed inside examination Hall
- Students should be seated as per Registration Number in the examination Hall.
- Students are not allowed to leave their place during 3 hours. Only 5-7 mins break for two times are allowed during examination with permission from the invigilator. A

washroom Register should be maintained with Name in and Out time.

- Question paper and Answer Sheet booklet will be given 10 mins before the exam. Kindly note no additional booklet will be provided to the students.
- The Question Paper will be given 10 mins before the schedule start of the exam. 5 Mins cool off time will be provided to students to go through the Question Paper before the scheduled time of the Examination
- Students should bring there ID cards and Hall ticket in the examination hall. Absence of any such will be deemed ineligible
- Student must ensure that he/she does not posses' mobile phones, programable calculator or any other electronic gadgets. They are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall.
- Candidates are directed to be in formal dress for examination
- Students, who is late by more than 15mins shall not be admitted in examination hall (except for circumstances beyond his/her control).
- No extra time will be allowed to students who arrives late in the exam hall.
- Students must fill the front page of their booklet before answering the question paper.
- Student must write their answers using (black/blue ink) and are not allowed to use any other ink.
- Do not write anything on the question paper except your registration number.
- Do not tear any page out of answer booklet. Last page of booklet can be used for rough work.
- Stop writing when your instructed to do so at the end of the examination. Leave the hall when you are asked by the invigilator.
- In case any candidate finds in possession of any of the prohibited items or involved in any kind of malpractice /unfair practices, action will be taken against the candidates in accordance with the provision.
- College authorities are not responsible for the **Mobile phones** confiscated during examination and they **will not be returned** to the students.

  - (b) The Answer Sheet should be in PDF Format

**2. Eligibility for Exams**

1. The eligibility criteria for the students to take the exam are based on Attendance for each Module, Payment of Dues and Appearance in MTA exam.

2. The minimum attendance required to appear in the examination is 75%. The only area of exception is on medical grounds where appropriate documents need to be submitted to the academic office. Under any given circumstances including medical grounds, Self-Marriage, Demise in the family, Pregnancy and Maternity, and Participation in Institutional Activity students are allowed to appear in the Complimentary Examination.
3. Course Faculty can waive 5%, 10% can be waived by the Dean, Academics, and Controller of examinations, and the Director is empowered to decide for students till 60% with subjective evidence. If the attendance is less than 60% then the student will be denied permission to appear in the examination.
4. The final list of students eligible for the examinations is prepared by the Academic office.
5. An overall attendance of 60% is mandatory in both years to be eligible for End semester examinations

***Process of addressing grievances for the shortage of attendance / MTA marks***

1. Any issues pertaining to the eligibility of the students to take the exams should be addressed to the Controller of Examinations and the Dean, of Academics.
2. Counseling needs to be undertaken for each student individually and an undertaking letter needs to be collected from the student regarding the status of his/her eligibility to take the exam. (Undertaking letter enclosed)
3. Counseling for the students should be undertaken individually based on the MTA marks and attendance.

**Hall Ticket**

- A candidate entering the examination hall must possess a hall-ticket and identity card issued by the authorities concerned
- No candidates should be admitted to the examination hall without ID card and Hall ticket
- In case of the absence of a hall ticket/ID card candidate has to submit a request in proper format which should be duly signed by the COE and dean academics for Provisional Admission
- The Admit Cards of all candidates should be verified during all sessions of the Examination

### 3. Schedule for Examination

1. The schedule for the examination should be issued by the Academic office and printed a week before the exams.
2. Invigilation: The Controller of Examination will schedule the invigilation duty of faculty. Schedule will be circulated among the faculty for their signature. Each faculty should ensure to be present for the invigilation on the assigned day.
3. For every 30 students, 1 faculty shall be assigned for invigilation. If case of more than 30 students in the same hall, 1 faculty should be supported by 1 staff member. Assigned invigilator should report atleast 30 mins before the actual time of commencement of exam.
4. In case the faculty/ staff assigned on invigilation duty on the specified day is unable to do the invigilation, it is her/his responsibility to make alternative arrangements and inform by writing the same in mail to the Controller of Examination.
5. Code of conduct:
  - (a) A code of conduct should be issued to all the students and acknowledgement should be collected .
  - (b) Dos & Don'ts: Invigilators should follow the Do's and Don't during the invigilation duty (Attached for reference)
  - (c) Answer Booklets: The answer booklets for the end term have been created separately. No additional booklets will be provided to students.
  - (d) Seating Arrangement in the Examination hall: The seating arrangement in the examination hall with roll numbers should be assigned 1 day prior and should be

changed for each paper to avoid malpractice.

#### **4. Obstruction in Conduct of Examination :**

If Examination cannot be conducted due to unforeseen reasons , the particular exam will be conducted as per the dates issued by the COE based on suggestions from examination committee meeting.

#### **5. Evaluations**

1. The answer booklets (Any confidentiality /Anonymous Sheet) for evaluations are submitted to the course coordinator after the completion of the term end examination by the Academic office.
2. The evaluations should be completed within 14 days of receiving the answer scripts from the Academic Office.

#### **6. Result Announcement**

1. The results will be prepared by the Examination Cell and verified by the Controller of Examination and Dean-Academics.
2. The Controller of Examination shall hold a meeting with the Examination Committee to review the results before announcing the results.
3. The results will be signed by the Chairperson, Controller of Examination, and Dean of Academics and displayed on the notice board.
4. Failure: A student who does not procure the minimum marks for qualifying i.e. 50 marks out of 100 is termed as 'failed'. The 50-mark aggregate is a sum of both MTA and TEE. It's compulsory for students to Secure 15 Marks out of 30 in MTA and 35 out of 70 in TEE Examination.

#### **7. Grace marks**

A total of 8 marks for the entire 2 years is available as 'grace' - the tally of which is maintained by the Controller of Examination's office. These grace marks can be used only if the candidate has failed in 2 or less than 2 subjects. If in a given term the candidate has failed in 3 subjects the concept of grace marks is not applicable. Students who would like to avail the grace marks shall submit the letter to the Controller of Examination. Controller of Examination shall call for a meeting with the Examination Committee and decide. In case a student is granted grace marks, Examination Committee should duly sign and keep record of the same for future use.

## 5. Re-Examination

1. **Supplementary exam:** The students who were not eligible due to shortage of attendance or failed in the exams have to take the supplementary exam in the next cycle of exams or otherwise whenever held by the Controller of Examinations. Supplementary Should be of 70 Marks Examination.
2. Students are allowed to appear only once for the supplementary exam for each module. Those who fail after writing a supplementary exam once for a subject/module will have to appear for the exam with the next batch.
3. Students will be marked as "P" in their score card irrespective of the marks they score in the supplementary exam.
4. **Complementary Exam:** A complementary exam will be conducted for the students who were absent either due to illness or taken leave for bank loans upon approval of the Course Coordinator and Dean of Academics. **This excludes ineligible candidates**
5. The students appearing for supplementary must pay fees prescribed by the management.

## 8. Re-Evaluation & Sitting for Supplementary Exam

1. *Re-evaluation of the answer scripts can be done on the payment of Rs.500/ (Five Hundred) per subject. A student can re-evaluate a maximum of three papers per term. In case there is a difference of marks the Academic office will consider the highest for the purpose of result.*
  2. The score sheet of the previous evaluation will be blinded and not available to the evaluator while doing a re-evaluation. Re-evaluation scores should be marked in the separate evaluation sheet/scoring sheet available in the answer booklet.
  3. For the Repeat Examination (Supplementary Exam) students need to deposit Rs 500/- as Repeat Examination fees at the institute account.
  4. For Repeat Examination (Supplementary Exam) students need to deposit Rs 500/- as Repeat Examination fees and Rs 1000 for Re-Repeat examinations at the institute account and submit the supplementary form to the examination cell
9. **Summer Training Program - Details of Summer Training is shared in Summer Training Guidelines.**

## 10. Dissertation

The Dissertation details are shared in the Dissertation Guidelines.

## 11. Retention of End-Term Exam Answer Scripts

The end-term answer scripts in physical will be retained for 7 years after the student has completed the course.

## 12. Time Duration for Clearing the Exams

After the completion of the course, a maximum of 3 years is provided to clear all exams, if, not the student is not eligible for the PG Diploma. Any deviation from this needs the approval of the Dean-Academics and the Director's approval. Any approval cannot exceed 5 years.

The prime objective of the Squad is: -

- a. Make a surprise invigilation at the Examination Hall during the Examination Scheduled by Controller of Examination and check the students , and their activities.
- b. Proper maintenance of Record such as Date, Time and Activity Found during invigilation must be maintained for record purposes.
- c. The above squad shall meet after the conclusion of each TEE on the dates fixed by the COE and inquire on all matters connected with the students booked under malpractices. After a detailed inquiry, the committee shall prepare a Report giving its recommendation on the penalties and punishments to be imposed, for the consideration by Controller of Examination, Associate Dean Academics and Student Affairs and Director.

The List of Malpractice that Squad should take into consideration while doing Invigilation.

1. Misbehaviour with officials or any kind of rude behavior in and around Examination Hall using obscene or abusing language
2. Writing on the Question paper / Piece of paper or passing it to the other student in the Examination Hall
3. Disclosing identity by writing any words or by making any distinct marks on the pages other than the facing sheet in the answer scripts while answering.
4. Possession of Electronic devises like Mobile, Programmable Calculator, Pendrive, Smart Watch/ Nano IPods or any other electronic devises / storage devises in the examination hall.
5. Communicating with any student or any other person inside or outside the examination hall with a view to take assistance or aid to write answers in the examination. Having any written matter on scribbling pad, calculator, palm, hand, leg, handkerchiefs, clothes, socks, Instrument box, Identity card, Scales etc.
6. Copying from the material or matter or answer(s) of another student or from similar aid or assistance rendered by another within the Examination Hall.
7. Making any request of representation or offer of any threat for inducement or bribery to Room Superintendent and / or any other official for favours in the Examination Hall or in the answer script
8. Approaching directly or indirectly the teaching staff, officials or examiners or bring about undue pressure or influence or influence upon them for favour in the examination.



9. Smuggling out or smuggling in the answer script pages or supplementary sheets or tearing them off and/or inserting pages written outside the examination hall into the answer scripts.
10. Receiving material from outside or inside the Examination Hall for the purpose of copying.
11. Bringing into the Examination Hall or being found in possession of portions of a book, manuscript, or such other material or matter to be brought into the Examination Hall.
12. Copying or taking aid from any material or matter.
13. Having any written matter or scribbling pad, calculator, palm, hand, leg or any other part of the body, hand kerchiefs, clothing, socks, instrument box, identity card, Hall Ticket, Scales etc.,
14. Destroying any evidence of malpractice, like tearing or mutilating the answer script(s) or running away along with the answer script(s) from the examination hall or premises.

## 14. Scheme of Examination

There shall be six term-end examinations (TEEs), one at the end of each term I, II Part A and B, III- and IV-Part A and B. The examination for both Term I and Term II Part A and B for all courses in First year for PGDM shall be common. In second the modules will be based on the specialization they opt for.

## 15. Criteria to Pass in Subjects

### 15.1. First Year Examination

**Main Subjects:** The student is declared to have passed in a subject, if he/she secures, 50% of marks minimum in MTA and Term End individually.

### 15.2. Second Year Examination

**Main Subjects:** The student is declared to have passed the examination in a subject if he/she secures 50% of the marks minimum in MTA and Term End individually.

## 16. Criteria to Pass in First Year Examination

The student shall be declared to have passed in first year examination if he/she passes in all the main subjects.

## 17. Carry Over Benefit for First Year

A student who fails in any 5 of the 14 main subjects of the first year shall be permitted to carry over those subjects to the second year.

## 18. Eligibility to appear in Final Semester Examinations

A Student without a minimum of 60% attendance in both years will not be permitted to appear in final semester examinations.

## 19. Eligibility to Award the PGDM Degree

1. Transcript - A student shall have passed in all the subjects of first, second year and also submit the summer training report along with the dissertation report to be eligible for award of degree Certificates.

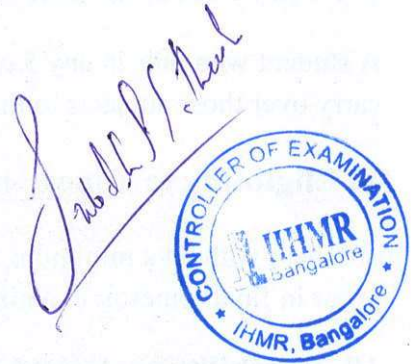
- A Gold Medal will be awarded to a student who has passed all the prescribed examinations in first attempt and scored highest marks in the respective specialisation
